Racial bitterness broke out at the Mexico Olympics today with two American Negroes giving protest salutes from the victors' rostrum.

The classical art of Black Power crashed through the idealism of the Olympic Games and brought a torrent of boos from white American athletes, officials and fans.

The salute came from American Negro sprinters Tommie Smith and John Carlos, gold and bronze medal winners in the 200 metres.

Wearing black gloves they raised their arms high to the air in a symbol of mastery while the National Anthem was played.

With them stood Australian Peter Norman, a Sunday school teacher, who won the Olympic 200-metre sprint gold.

Carlos looked at the crowd and said: "They just want to see nothing but athletes. We are not of athletes for the white people."

Their protest was to show that "black people are equal."

He later said he would not attend another Olympic unless the gold had been won. "This could mean he will boycott the 1972 Games in Munich."
