Key areas of the Northern Ireland Curriculum Key Stage 3 Learning for Life and Work Key Concepts and Learning Outcomes covered in each lesson

Lesson 1: What is news?	Local and Global Citizenship Strand. Key Concept – Democracy and Active Participation. Investigate the basic characteristics of democracy e.g. free press and the media.
Lesson 2: Finding and gathering the news	Learning Outcomes. Research and manage information effectively (utilising the internet, newspapers, television, texts and ICT based sources) to investigate citizenship issues, explore problems, undertake action projects and make informed decisions.
Lesson 3: Writing a news report	Learning Outcomes. Work independently to manage, evaluate and improve own learning and performance.
Lesson 4: Assembling a news report	Learning Outcomes. Demonstrate creativity, initiative, organisation and perseverance in carrying out tasks and developing own ideas.
Lesson 5: Ordering the news	Learning Outcomes Communicate effectively in visual, oral, written and ICT formats, showing clear awareness of audience and purpose, for example, in role-play scenarios, presentations and other tasks.  Work effectively within teams.
Lesson 6: Broadcasting the news	Personal Development Strand, PSHE. Key concept – Personal Understanding. Develop study skills e.g. time management, organisation and recognition of own style etc. Learning Outcomes. Communicate effectively in visual, oral, written and ICT formats, showing clear awareness of audience and purpose, for example, in role-play scenarios, presentations and other tasks.
