

## **Activity: Using the internet safely**

Your teacher has given you a card with information about someone who needs your help to learn how to use the internet safely. In small groups, read the card carefully and answer the questions.

After 10 minutes, your teacher will ask you to discuss your answers with the rest of the class.

### **Jake - 8 years old**

- 1) What social networks should Jake use?
- 2) Recommend three news sources that Jake could look at
- 3) Jake wants to upload a video of his sister's birthday party to the internet, so his Gran can see it. What should he do?

### **Emma – 11 years old**

- 1) What social networks should Emma use?
- 2) Recommend three news sources that Emma could look at
- 3) Emma likes to chat with her friends and family using instant messaging services. Somebody she doesn't know asks to her to chat privately online. What should she do?

### **Kierra - 16 years old**

- 1) What social networks should Kierra use?
- 2) Recommend three news sources for Kierra
- 3) Kierra is having a party. She posts the details online so her friends will be able to see all the details. What are the risks of this?

### **Noel – 19 years old**

- 1) What social networks should Noel use?
- 2) Recommend three news sources for Noel
- 3) Noel is travelling round the world and uses lots of different computers to send e-mails, use social networks and upload pictures. What security issue should he think about?

### **Steve - 35 years old**

- 1) What social networks should Steve use?
- 2) Recommend three news sources for Steve
- 3) Steve went to a party and took lots of pictures. He wants to share them with his friends. What are the risks?

### **Grace - 60 years old**

- 1) What social networks should Grace use?
- 2) Recommend three news sources for Grace
- 3) Grace is getting nasty e-mails from an anonymous e-mail address. What can she do?
