## Winged Seeds

Lime Wych Elm

Plant the seeds to at least twice their depth in pots, trays or seed beds

Collect the ripe cones or catkins, dry out for two weeks at room temperature, shake or rub them between your hands, and sow.

Separate seeds from the prickly outer casing. Drop the seeds in water. Plant only those that sink.

Drop the seeds in water. Plant only those that sink.

Give seeds planted immediately germinate next spring. Brown seeds take 18 months to germinate.

Place berries in plastic bag. Allow the flesh to rot (approx. 3 weeks), then wash away flesh to leave seed. Plant.
