Saturday 2nd May

southeastern.

- Charing Cross, Cannon Street and Waterloo East will be closed.
- Only services from Hastings will serve London Bridge, all others will run to Victoria or Blackfriars.
- Buses replace rains between Lewisham and Charlton (via Greenwich)

SOUTHERN

Trains between London Bridge and Horsham will start/end at East Croydon

First  **Great Western**

Some trains between Paddington and Reading won't run. Trains between Greenford and Paddington will start/end at Ealing Broadway

Sunday 3rd May

southeastern.

- Charing Cross and Waterloo East will be closed with trains diverting to/from Cannon Street.
- Buses replace trains between Denmark Hill / Greenwich and Dartford / Gravesend
- No trains between Brixton and Shortlands, instead they'll divert via Catford. Buses will run between Denmark Hill and Shortlands calling at all stations, except Brixton.
- Trains between Cannon Street and Sevenoaks/Orpington won't call at New Cross, St Johns or Hither Green.

SOUTHERN

Trains will run between London Bridge and West Croydon

(Southbound stopping services will call at all stations, but Northbound services will run fast calling at Norwood Junction and New Cross Gate only).

If using Brockley, Honor Oak Park, Forest Hill, Sydenham, Penge West or Anerley then you should go via New Cross Gate / Norwood Junction using Southbound services

GATWICK EXPRESS

A half hourly service will run all day

- Buses replace services on the Shenfield Metro line (from Shenfield, Brentwood, Harold Wood, Gidea Park and Romford to Newbury Park to change with the tube)
- Buses will replace Southend Victoria services from Wickford to Newbury Park
- Buses will replace mainline and Intercity services from Ingatestone to Newbury Park

SOUTH WEST TRAINS

Works at Waterloo will affect long-distance trains and suburban services through Wimbledon.

In addition...

- No trains at Earlsfield or Queensown Road (Battersea)
- Trains between Waterloo and Chessington South will start/end at Wimbledon
- Trains between Waterloo and Guildford (via Leatherhead) will start/end at Wimbledon
- Trains between Waterloo and Hampton Court will start/end Surbiton
- Trains between Waterloo and Woking (via Hounslow) will start/end at Clapham Junction
- Trains between Waterloo and Dorking will start/end Wimbledon

Sunday 3rd May

Thameslink

Works are closing the line between Blackfriars and Tulse Hill. This means...

- No trains South of St Pancras/Blackfriars
- Two trains an hour between London Bridge and Brighton
- Trains on the Wimbledon/Sutton loop will run between Luton and Blackfriars, and between London Bridge and Sutton only.
(Trains between London Bridge and Sutton will run non-stop between London Bridge and Tulse Hill, then call at all stations between Tulse Hill and Sutton via Wimbledon)
- No trains between St Albans and Sutton via Mitcham Junction



No service between South Tottenham and Barking, and between New Cross Gate and West Croydon and Crystal Palace
